The **<u>Canadian Online Job Posting Dashboard</u>** is a search tool hosting data scraped from online job postings in Canada. For a given geography and time period, users can search by **job title** or by **work requirement**.

Approximately **90%** of job postings captured by Vicinity Jobs are matched to a specific geographic location within a province or territory.

Job postings organized by occupations at 4 levels of detail:

- NOC1 Broad
- (e.g., Health occupations)
- NOC2 Major Group
 - NOC3 Minor Group (e.
- (e.g., Technical occupations in health)
 - (e.g., Technical occupations in dental health care)
- • NOC4 Unit Group
- (e.g., Denturists)

NOC stands for National Occupation Classification. NOCs are used to group occupations based on the type of work performed (e.g., tasks, duties). The data in the dashboard matches job postings to their detailed NO<u>C codes.</u>
